

REVIEW OF COUNCILLORS REPRESENTATION Discussion Paper

As part of the Local Government Reforms process, the Shire of Kondinin has been requested by the Minister for Local Government to reduce our Councillor numbers from 9 to 7. This can either be through a voluntary process or forced by the Department through legislation.

The Shire of Kondinin has decided to look at this on a voluntary basis and has drafted a discussion paper on the matter. It is a requirement under the Local Government Act that this be made available for a period of 6 weeks, but given the time of year, the Shire has allowed it to remain open for an extended period to close on: **4pm on 30th January 2023**

Harvest has started and we are reminding people to please take care on the roads with all the trucks moving around as well.

OCTOBER MEETING

At the October Council Meeting, several items were presented to Council.

This included:

- Council acceptance of a new Building Maintenance Tender for all the Shire buildings including housing.
- Changes to Lot 331 for DFES facilities have been approved in principle.
- Council adopted an easement agreement for Lots 108 and 109 on the Kondinin-Hyden Road in Karlgarin
- The Freedom of Information Statement for the Shire was adopted for the 2022/23 year.
- Minutes from the WALGA AGM were received by Council.
- Council has agreed to support an Off Road Racing Event for next year within our Shire providing that use of roads is minimal.
- Recent changes in staffing have required an amendment to our Purchasing Policy.
- A new Lease Arrangement has been approved for Waveline in Hyden.
- Draft Local Laws adopted for: Fencing Local Law

SLOGAN FEEDBACK -WAVE ROCK OWNERSHIP

Thanks to all the residents that responded to our information on the slogan for the Shire, there were some very good suggestions that we have tried to take on board. This will be presented to Council this month. An interesting note from the comments was concerns that any promotion of Wave Rock would only be a benefit to a private business as it was run by a private business. This is not correct. The Wave Rock Reserve is currently owned by the State Government for water resources but is managed by the Shire. We collect approximately \$60,000+ per year from this facility (current year) which goes back into providing the facilities such as toilets or bush tucker garden at Wave Rock and promoting facilities in other areas.

The Shire is currently marketing our other attractions to encourage people to stay longer in our district which will increase tourist dollars generating more income for our Shire and local businesses. This was recently included in the Australia Golden Outback posts.

So promoting Wave Rock and our other attractions brings benefit to the Shire and our communities, not just a single private operator.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT REFORM

The Minister for Local Government has written to all Local Governments with a community of fewer than 5,000 residents and more than 7 Council Members to consider a reduction in Members through a voluntary process or legislative process.

The Shire has released a discussion paper for the reduction of Members to 7 in compliance with the forthcoming reform.

SHIRE OF KONDININ Adoption of Local Laws

The Council has resolved to adopt the following local laws -

1.Shire of Kondinin Bush Fire Brigades Local Law Purpose - to make provisions for establishment, management and administration of Bush Fire Brigades in accordance with the Bush Fires Act 1954.

Effect - to align the requirements for Bush Fire Brigades with legislation and local practice.

2. Shire of Kondinin Cemeteries Local Law;

Purpose - to provide for the management of cemeteries within the district and create offences for noncompliance.

Effect - to provide for the management and control of cemeteries.

3. Shire of Kondinin Dogs Local Law

Purpose - to make provisions about the impounding, the number that may be kept on premises, the manner of keeping dogs and create offences for non-compliance.

Effect - to repeal existing Dogs Local Law 1995 and provide for the controls of dogs within the district and impose penalties for non-compliance.

4. Shire of Kondinin Public Places and Local Government Property Local Law

Purpose - to make provisions for the management of public places, thoroughfares and all local government property

Effect - to repeal existing local laws, establish necessary controls for public places, thoroughfares and local government property, provide for permitted and prohibited use and activities, and create offences for noncompliance

> 5.Shire of Kondinin Repeal Local Law Purpose - to revoke old local laws no longer having relevance Effect - revocation of outdated requirements and local laws.

Copies of the local laws may be inspected at or obtained from the Administration Offices in Kondinin and Hyden during normal office hours, or from the Shire's website.

These local laws were published in the Government Gazette on 10 November 2022, and come into effect on 25 November 2022.
