





The mural depicts one of the many brave men who had to leave their wives and children behind during the disastrous drought of 1914, leaving early farming progress and communities in ruin.

SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

There is no meeting in January, however, the Shire did have a Special Meeting earlier this month to look at a couple of time-critical items. This included:

- Hyden Barracks and the shifting to a new location. A submission was received from the community for this project and accepted by Council.
- Review of submission and final determination for Report of Review of Representation for the Shire, which will look at reducing our elected members from 9 to 7 in line with local government reforms.

KONDININ TRIATHLON

Kondinin Triathlon is being held this weekend on Saturday.

We hope people will come down and cheer on our athletes as they go through the competition.

ROADWORKS

Our road crew is expecting to finish the works on the Kondinin-Narembeen Road in February and will then be moving onto other roads within this Shire including Karlgarin-Pederah Road and Tolland Road.

We have also had our funding confirmed for the Hyden Norseman Road which will see \$5m go towards sealing a 20km section of the road as a Pilot Project.

DOCTOR SERVICES

As some may be aware, Dr Mackie is looking at retiring this year. The Shire is currently working with the Shire of Kulin for a replacement Doctor.

Some of you may have seen a prospective candidate recently at the Medical Centres having a look at our operations and centres.

CURRENT PROJECTS ON THE GO

The Shire has several projects on the go at the moment as well as items passed at the last Council Meeting. This is an update on these projects.

- Hyden Swimming Pool change room renovations will be starting soon. This project is approximately \$600,000; Renovations have started. We do apologise for any inconvenience caused from this.
- Grant funds have been received for 8 courts of the Hyden Tennis Club to be replaced. This project will also be done with funds from the Hyden Tennis club and the Shire - cost estimate \$285.000.
- The footpath upgrade to Kondinin medical services (part 1) was recently completed. Part 2 will be commencing soon and completing the path past the Kondinin Primary School. This was part of the grantfunded shared footpath program for \$200,000. The Shire has successfully applied for these funds on 3 previous occasions to secure funds for footpaths for Hyden Townsite to Wave Rock.

Healthier Frozen Fruity Yoghurt Bark With Muesli



Prep: 5 Minutes



Ingredients

- 125g raspberries
- 1 1/2 cups reduced fat natural yoghurt
- 1/2 tsp vanilla extract
- 2 tsp pure maple syrup
- 1/4 cup muesli
- 1/4 cup toasted coconut flakes

Method

- 1. Line a 30 x 20cm baking tray with baking paper, allowing paper to overhang for handles.

 Using a fork, mash raspberries in a bowl until almost pureed.
- 2. Whisk yoghurt, vanilla and maple syrup in a large bowl until combined.
- 3. Spread yoghurt mixture over prepared tray. Smooth surface.
- 4. Drizzle with puree. Top with muesli and coconut flakes. Freeze for 3-4 hours or until firm.
- 5. Cut into pieces and serve.
