WATERING ROSTER AT COMMUNITY GARDEN

Coming into the warmer months we will again need to hand water the community garden. Below is the current roster. Please contact Kirstie at the Shire on kncco@kondinin.wa.gov.au or 9889 1006 if you are still happy to be on the existing roster or if you are not on the roster and would like to be. It takes around 30 minutes once a fortnight.

NB* Throughout the warmer months please water all areas of the garden including sections on the reticulation.

AREA 1 (SOUTHERN SECTION OF GARDEN)

The planter box on the men's toilets, the pots on the deck, the mulberry tree, the plants behind the stand up sleepers near the fire pit, the bush tucker garden, the rosemary path, any other pots in this vicinity of the garden not connected to reticulation and under the old kiosk.

AREA 2 (NORTHERN SECTION OF GARDEN)

The handbags on the fence, plants around the nature play area in the pots, beds and path, the plants behind the stand-up sleepers and along the fence between the garden and nature play area, the succulents in the bath tubs, the planter box in the ladies toilet, the pot plants under the kiosk and the planter boxes under the kiosk.

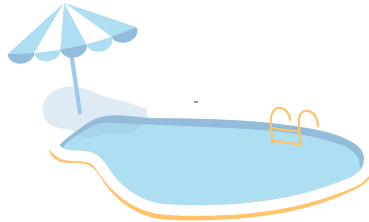
SCHEDULED MAINTENANCE AT HYDEN SWIMMING POOL

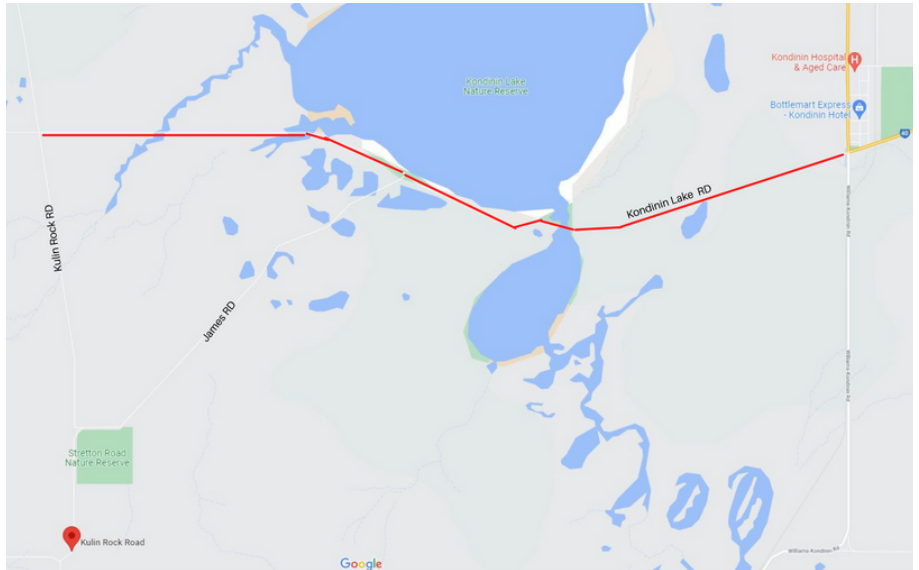


KONDININ ROAD CLOSURE AND WASTE STATION CLOSED

Selflessness recognised

On Friday, 25 November 2022 off-duty police officer, Sergeant Phil Woods, Officer in Charge at Kondinin Police was seriously assaulted at his home address.

The incident was witnessed and reported by his 14-year-old daughter, Lucy Woods while neighbours Vaughan and Rachel Andrews came to the aid of Sgt Woods, assisting in the apprehension of the offender until additional police arrived at the scene.

In December 2022, Commissioner Blanch, Deputy Commissioner Adams, Commander Wilde, Superintendent Coombes and officers from surrounding towns travelled to Kondinin, where the Commissioner presented Lucy, Vaughan and Rachel with Certificates of Appreciation for their courage and selflessness in assisting Sgt Woods. Kondinin Emergency Services personnel and other local community members were also in attendance.

The Commissioner expressed the gratitude of the WA Police Force for the efforts of the three recipients and said their response was an excellent example of the community's overwhelming support for police officers throughout the State and particularly in Regional WA.

4-Step Asian Pork Meatballs



Prep: 10 Minutes



Cook: 25 Minutes



Serves: 4

Ingredients

- 1 bunch Coriander
- 2 cm piece fresh ginger, peeled, finely grated
- 2 spring onions, chopped
- 520g crunchy noodle coleslaw kit
- 5ml virgin olive oil spray
- 450g microwave brown rice
- 500g extra lean pork mince
- 2 garlic cloves, crushed
- 300g carrot, shredded

Method

1. Preheat oven to 200°C. Combine mince, spring onion, ginger and garlic in a bowl. Finely chop coriander root and 3cm of stalks. Remove coriander sprigs and set aside. Add chopped coriander to mince. Stir until well combined. Form tablespoons of mixture into balls and place on a plate.
2. Heat a non-stick frying pan over medium heat. Spray with oil. Add meatballs and cook for 10 minutes, shaking pan occasionally, or until meatballs are browned all over. Add 1/2 cup water and bring to the boil.
3. Transfer mixture to a shallow baking dish and place in oven. Bake meatballs for 10 minutes or until cooked through.
4. Cook microwave rice as per packet instructions. Serve meatballs with coleslaw mixed with carrot and rice. Top with coriander sprigs.





CEO CORNER

Our thoughts and sincere condolences go to the family members of those lost in the accident near Kondinin early Christmas day.

We would also like to thank and acknowledge the emergency services teams that attended the accident.

DECEMBER MEETING

At the December Council Meeting, several items were presented to Council. This included:

- Development Application for a Telecommunications Tower on Hyden Norseman Road was approved. This is part of the Black Spot program.
- Approval was given for a mobile Veterinary Service to come to Kondinin and Hyden for a 12-month trial.
- Approval was given for an extension of a Holiday House in Hyden.
- Approval for the Hyden Tennis Club Roof for \$204,291 was approved to be completed before the Tennis seasons of 2023/2024.
- Relocation of the Hyden Railway Barracks was considered but remains on the table to allow for a local organisation to quote.
- A mural design for the JW West Building in Kondinin was approved.
- Council is supporting the installation of an Electric Vehicle Station in Hyden being funded through Synergy. Consideration of the best location is currently underway.
- One of the Community Buses is in need of a replacement for the Shire and options are being considered for funding.
- The Meeting Dates for 2023 have been established and are now available on the Shire Website.
- The Draft wording for the Shire of Kondinin Corporates Business Plan was accepted with final costing to be provided.
- Council considered the WALGA Governance review and included its thoughts on the process for the best outcome for our Shire.
- Council will be seeking a Request for Information for the Hyden Visitors/Community hub facility to allow for options for the working group to consider.

- Council also considered the medical fees currently being charged and are looking at a hybrid model with only eligible customers being billed. This reduces the cost impact of medical services on all ratepayers.
- Support was given for new signage for the Kondinin Memorial Garden in the 2023-2024 Budget considerations.

UPDATE ON SHIRE LOGO

At a recent workshop, Council considered the changes to the logo and is having difficulties in finding an appropriate new logo that will fairly represent the Shire. Considerations retaining the current logo were also considered to reduce the costs of having to replace the logo.

If there is a strong push for the Shire to update the logo, it will be taken further, otherwise, we may retain the current logo and look at a change when it is more suitable.

ROADWORKS

Our road crew are expecting to finish the works on the Kondinin-Naremben Road in February and will then be moving onto other roads within this Shire including Karlgarin-Pederah Road and Tolland Road.

We have also had our funding confirmed for the Hyden Norseman Road which will see \$5m go towards sealing a 20km section of the road as a Pilot Project.

COMMUNITY SURVEYS AND FEEDBACK

Residents are reminded that the Shire currently has a discussion paper available for information and comment in regards to the recent request by the Minister for Local Government for band 3 and 4 Shires to consider reducing the number of Elected Members to 7 (we currently have 9).

The Shire of Kondinin is looking at how we can be compliant with the request rather than allowing the decision to be made for us. Feedback is requested by 30th January 2023.

CURRENT PROJECTS ON THE GO

The Shire has several projects on the go at the moment as well as items passed at the last Council Meeting. This is an update on these projects.

- Hyden Swimming Pool change room renovations will be starting soon. This project is approximately \$600,000;
- Grant funds have been received for 8 courts of the Hyden Tennis Club to be replaced. This project will also be done with funds from the Hyden Tennis club and the Shire - cost estimate \$285,000;
- Shire is working with the Department of Water for water security including water from Yeerakine Dam, additional tanks installed at Kings Rocks, new tanks to be installed at the Humps and new pumps at the Kondinin CBH Dam, all part of the Community Water Supply grant funds.
- The first section of the footpath upgrades along Graham St has been recently completed. This is part of the grant-funded shared footpath program for \$200,000. The Shire has successfully applied for these funds on 3 previous occasions to secure funds for footpaths for Hyden Townsite to Wave Rock.
- Our Development Officers are currently working with the working groups for the Kondinin Gourmet in the Garden, Kondinin Blue Light Disco with Police, Kondinin Triathlon, a Comic/Circus Show for children for Hyden, the Hyden Mural Project for Coronation Park and upgrade to the Wave Rock Bush Tucker Signs.
