Adoption of Local Law

The Council has resolved to adopt a Fencing Local Law –

Purpose – to prescribe sufficient fences, the standard for construction of fences and create offences for non-compliance.

Effect – to establish the minimum requirements for fencing, provide for permitted and prohibited fencing, and create offences for non-compliance.

A copy of the local law may be inspected at or obtained from the Administration Offices in Kondinin and Hyden during normal office hours, or from the Shire's website.

The local law was published in the Government Gazette on **8 September 2023** and comes into effect on **23 September 2023**.

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this Business Plan is to:

1. Inform the community the Shire of Kondinin proposes to borrow funds to develop group housing on No. 51 (Lot 121) Rankin Street, Kondinin and lease it to WA Country Health Services;
2. Provide opportunity for the community to consider and make informed submissions on the Business Plan; and
3. Satisfy the requirements of Section 3.59 of the Local Government Act 1995.

Kondinin Hospital Staff Housing

The Kondinin Hospital Staff Housing will consist of:

Two 2 bedroom, 2 bathroom units with self-contained kitchen, lounge, laundry and carport
Fencing and low-maintenance landscaping

The Shire of Kondinin is proposing to borrow funds to construct the units and lease the property to the WA Country Health Service for 10 years with the intention for a further 10 years on a cost recovery basis.

August Council Meeting

- At the August Ordinary Meeting, the following items were considered by Council:
- Approval of a re-alignment of lot boundaries for the Kondinin Sporting Precinct, for the Recreation Area, Caravan Park and Shire Depot.
- Tenders accepted for Cleaning Services for the Shire.
- A change in the freehold lots for the Karlgarin Bowling Greens.
- A rental increase for 76 Graham Street, currently rented to WA Country Health Services (WACHS).
- Consolidation of Reserves in Graham Street, Kondinin, for Recreation Purposes (Swimming Pool and Community Garden).
- Consideration of an Easement near the Hyden Town Hall to give better access to Coronation Park.
- Adoption of the 2023/2024 Annual Budget.
- Actions for the Hyden Discovery Centre were approved and an update on the project provided to Council.

- Endorsement of the CEO starting the process of a Tourism Master Plan for the Shire was approved. The Bush Fire Control Officers for 2023/2024 were approved.
- The Prohibited Burning Period for 2023/2024 was approved
- A Contract for Medical Services was approved by Council allowing for the new Doctor to start.

Gnocchi with Pesto & Crispy



Chorizo

Total Time: 15 Minutes



Serves: 4



Ingredients

- 2 D'Orsonga Chorizo, thinly sliced
- 500g fresh gnocchi
- 400g broccoli, cut into florets
- 1 cup frozen peas
- 190g basil pesto
- 50g parmesan, finely grated
- 1/4 bunch basil, leaves picked

Method

- Preheat oven to 200°C/180°C fan-forced. Line a large baking tray with baking paper. Spread chorizo on the tray in a single layer and bake for 10 minutes, or until crispy. Remove from oven and set aside.
- Meanwhile, cook gnocchi in a large saucepan of boiling water, according to packet instructions. Add broccoli and peas in the last 2 minutes of cooking. Drain and set aside.
- Add pesto, gnocchi, peas and broccoli to a large bowl and toss to combine. Serve topped with chorizo, parmesan and basil.

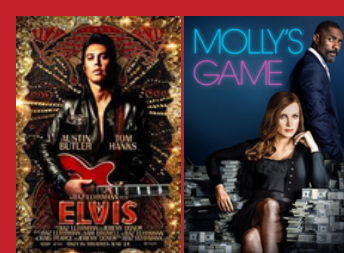
