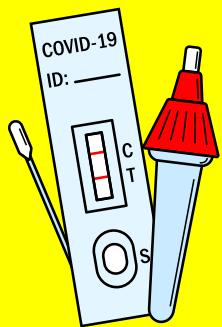

With the cold weather coming in, back yard fires are likely to be springing up to keep us warm on the chilly nights. Please be kind to your neighbours and advise them if you are looking at having a fire, just to ensure they do not have washing on the line.

Council Meetings

- For the May Ordinary Council Meeting, the following was discussed:
- The Shire will be applying to Public Transport Authority for more area in Hyden for displays near the Railway Goods Shed.
- Boundaries of properties near Kondinin Recreation Centre are being realigned to be more in line with the use of the various areas.
- Freehold lots of the Karlgarin Bowling Green will be transferred and amalgamated into the Crown Reserve.
- The proposed Differential Rates for 2024/2025 were considered and will be sent for approval.
- An update on the Discovery Centre was provided to Council.
- A request for waiver of entrance fees to Wave Rock for a Seniors Group was considered by Council.
- The Shire has approved the Hyden Progress Association to use shire buildings with a Section 55 permit for Seniors Luncheons and also to consider a contribution in the 2024/25 Budget.
- The Shire will be giving \$2,000 to the Kondinin Golf Club Centenary Event.
- Minutes of the Great Eastern Country Zone were noted.
- An Update report on Housing Matters for the Shire was considered by Council.

- Community Grants were considered by Council. While the grants have been accepted, they will still need to be included in the budget process. Letters will be sent out shortly for the applicants.

Many thanks to the staff and volunteers that worked hard for the ANZAC Day Services. Both services for the Shire were well attended and the gunfire breakfasts enjoyed by all.

HEALTHWAY – HEALTHY COMMUNITIES PROGRAM



This program aims to fund a range of health promotion activities and campaigns to promote and encourage healthy lifestyles for all Western Australians.

The objectives of the program are to:

- Fund activities related to the promotion of good health in general and aligned with our strategic priorities and population groups.
- Support projects that aim to increase individual knowledge and skills, change behaviour, and create community and organisational policies and environments to improve health.

How much can I apply for? There are three funding categories available: 1. Up to \$5,000 funding, 2. Over \$5,000 funding & 3. Aboriginal health project funding.

Slow Cooker Beef Stroganoff



Total Time: 4 Hr 30 Minutes



Serves: 4



Ingredients

- 650g Coles No Added Hormone Beef Brisket, trimmed, cut into 3cm pieces
- 2 tbsp Coles Classic Olive Oil
- 2 brown onions, thinly sliced
- 3 garlic cloves, thinly sliced
- 400g cup mushrooms, halved
- 2 tbsp Coles White Plain Flour
- 1 tbsp paprika
- 1 cup Massel beef stock
- 1 tbsp tomato paste
- 1 tbsp worcestershire sauce
- 1 1/2 tbsp Bulla Light Sour Cream
- Mashed potatoes or steamed rice, to serve
- 2 tbsp finely chopped parsley

Method

Step 1

- Season beef. Heat 1 tablespoon oil in a large frying pan over high heat. Cook 650g Coles No Added Hormone Beef Brisket, trimmed, cut into 3cm pieces in 2 batches, for 3 minutes each or until browned. Transfer to a 3L (12 cup) slow cooker.

Step 2

- Heat remaining oil in same pan over medium-high heat. Cook 2 brown onions, thinly sliced and 400g cup mushrooms, halved, stirring, for 5 minutes. Add 3 garlic cloves, thinly sliced and 2 tbsp Coles White Plain Flour and cook, stirring, for 1 minute. Transfer to cooker with 1 tbsp paprika. Combine 1 cup Massel beef stock, 1 tbsp tomato paste and 1 tbsp worcestershire sauce in a jug until smooth. Pour over beef. Stir to combine. Cover and cook on high for 4 1/2 hours or until beef is tender. Stir in 1 1/2 tbsp Bulla Light Sour Cream and season.

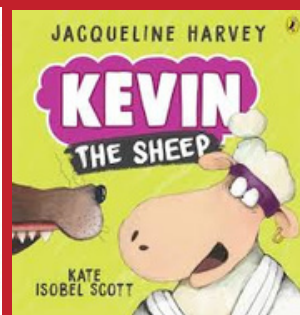
Step 3

- Serve with Mashed potatoes or steamed rice, to serve. Sprinkle with 2 tbsp finely chopped parsley.
