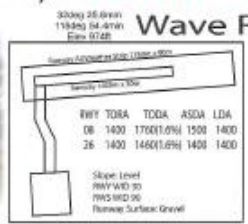
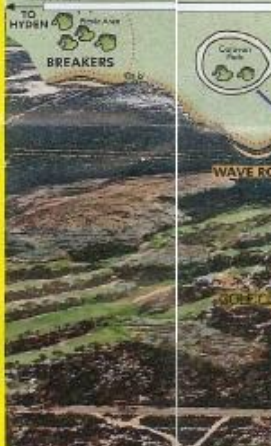

WALK TRAIL

Wave Rock Walk Circuit is part of the Woodlands Discovery Trail. A sealed walkway starts at the Visitor Centre and extends past the Wave Rock Airfield to the Wave Rock Resort and Lake Magic, across the lake to Hippo's Yawn, through the woodlands to Wave Rock. From Wave Rock, follow the brick path past the Wave Rock Caravan Park, Cabins and Kiosk and back to the Visitor Centre. This walk trail includes interpretive signage, boardwalk and many points of interest. It is 3.6km (2.2 miles) long. In hot weather, we advise you to take a drink bottle and hat. The sunset over Lake Magic is a feast for the eyes.

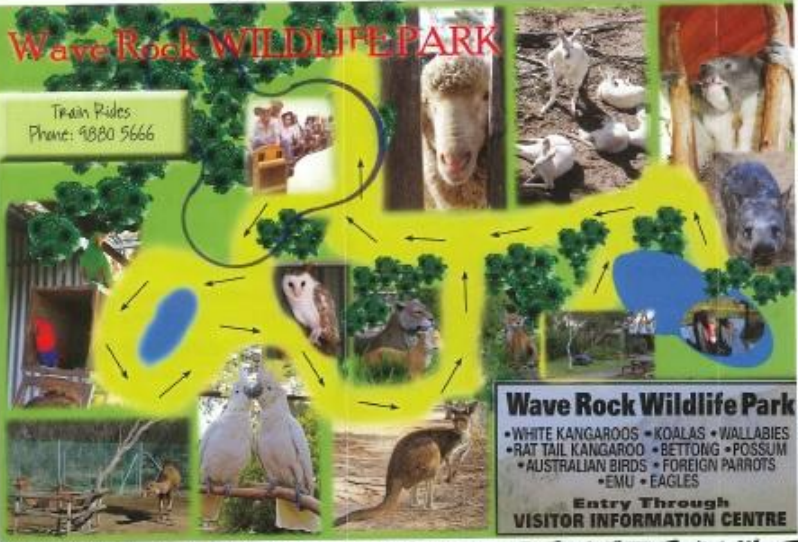

The Rabbit Proof Fence

The 50% drop in stock carrying capacity & the extensive damage to cereal crops following their spread, was evidence of the hundreds of millions of dollars rabbits were to cost Australia. Western Australia began construction of the No.1 Rabbit Proof Fence in 1901. Seven years of hard work followed - gangs of men, teams of horses, mules, camels, wagons, carts, picks and shovels, and a lot of sweat and tired muscles. When the fence was completed it was the longest fence in the world, stretching from Starvation Boat Harbour, just west of Esperance in the south, to Walla on the 80 Mile Beach in the north west. The fence cost an astronomical sum for the times. Even before completion, the rabbits were past the fence and work had begun on Fences No.2 and 3. By 1908 the three fences were complete, over 3,000km of fenceline in total!



Visitor Information Centre

Inside the front entry of this amazing complex you will find a Visitor Information counter. Our trained information officers will help you with attractions, mapping, surrounding and local area advice.

Wildflower Display

The major feature of this complex is the massive wildflower display, which hangs from the ceiling. Rows of colourful handpicked dried wildflowers line the ceiling in the main display and enormous butterflies, made over 72 hours each, adorn the roof spaces. On entry to the complex, a giant sized willflower bell will delight you.

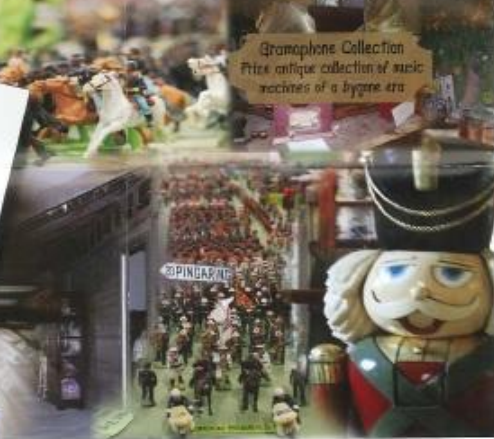

BOOKINGS ESSENTIAL

The Lace Place
 A museum specially built in 1990 to house the Blackburn Collection. The Margaret Blackburn to the West Australian Museum, was later purchased by the Mounts family of Hyden. Housed in beautiful hand crafted Jarrah cabinets. See the large collection of antique lace dating back to the 1600's including a piece of tulle from an off out of Princess Diana's wedding dress. Other laces on display include Honiton Brussels, Maltese Lace from the early 1900's to the present day including a fashion award winning exhibit.



Miniature Soldier Military Display
 The Alex Smith Miniature Soldier Military Display, (approx 6000 figures), is the result of over 50 years of collecting, restoring and re-producing toys. The display is arranged in pseudo diorama form with the toys portraying the period they represent.



The butterflies in the roof have been made by local craftsmen, an idea inspired by lack of funds to purchase lining for the building and the need for a more interesting view while enjoying lunch. These spectacular works of art each took many hours to complete.

Fixtures & fittings in the shop are built from natural bush timbers. Vintage cars, a dry, old shaver used by our early pioneers and a granite fire place with a large kettle fire, make this an inviting atmosphere.

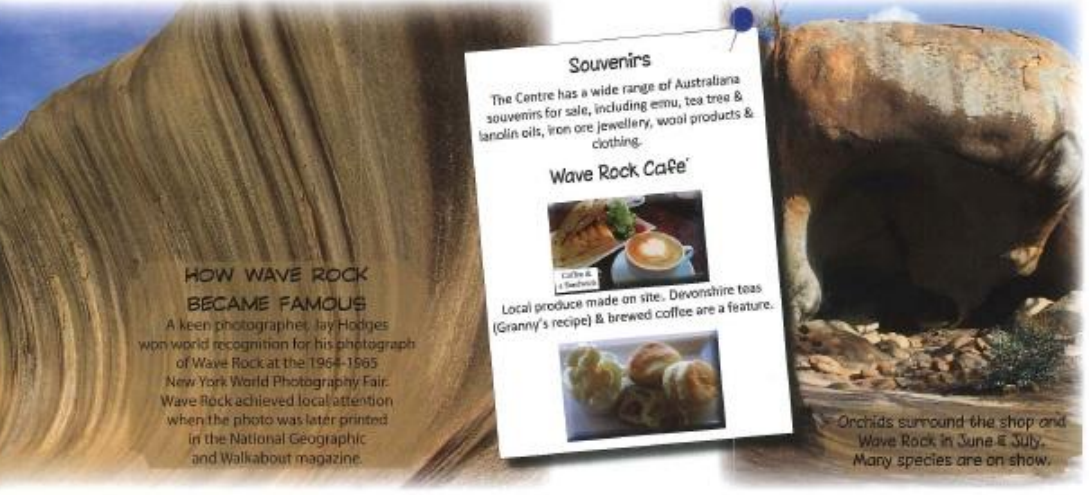

 A keen photographer, Jay Hodgins won world recognition for his photograph of Wave Rock at the 1964-1965 New York World Photography Fair. Wave Rock achieved local attention when the photo was later printed in the National Geographic and Walkabout magazine.
